Christmas & Hanukah Songs traditional carols arranged by Phyllis Avidan Louke. Oh Come All Ye Faithful, Joy to the World, Oh Hanukah, Silent Night, I Have a Little Dreidel, Oh Little Town of Bethlehem.

Parade of the Wooden Soldiers by Léon Jessel and arranged by Thomas Gordon Campbell. This popular Christmas tune was made famous by the Fleischer Studios animated short starring Betty Boop.

Pat-A-Pan a traditional French carol arranged by James Christensen. The carol tells of the birth of Jesus from the perspective of shepherds playing drums (patapan) and flutes (tr-re-lu-re-lu).

The Christmas Song by Mel Tormé and arranged by Janet Diehl. This tune is often referred to as "Chestnuts Roasting on an Open Fire" and was written during a blistering hot summer. It is the most performed Christmas Song.

Frosty the Snowman by Steve Nelson and Jack Rollins and arranged by Jeff Jarvis.

O Holy Night by Adolphe Adam and arranged by Tracy Kirkman. The lyrics to this beautiful carol are from a French poem called "Minuit, chrétiens" by Placide Cappeau.

Christmas & Hanukah Songs traditional carols arranged by Phyllis Avidan Louke. Hark the Herald Angels Sing, What Child is This, Jingle Bells, Angels WE Have Heard on High.

Dance of the Reed Pipes by Peter Tschaikowsky and arranged by James Christensen. This song is a movement from the Nutcracker ballet which was first performed on December 18, 1892 at the Imperial Mariinsky Theatre in St. Petersburg, Russia.

Carols for Flutes Christmas songs arranged by Ricky Lombardo. Up On the Housetop, March of the Toys.

Rudolph the Red Nosed Reindeer written by Johnny Marks and arranged by James Christensen. Robert May created Rudolph as an assignment during his employment by Montgomery Ward and 8 years later was able to convince the corporation to give him the copyright.

Child in the Manger, Infant of Mary a Gaelic melody arranged by Amy Rice-Young. This English Christmas carol is most known as Morning Has Broken.

For Unto Us a Child is Born by Georg Frederic Handel and arranged by Sondra K. Tucker. Handel's Messiah is thought to be the most performed music in all of history.

We Three Kings / Carol of the Bells Two interwoven carols arranged by Phyllis Avidan Louke.

Feliz Navidad by José Feliciano and arranged by Ricky Lombardo. José Feliciano, a Puerto Rican singer-songwriter, wrote this piece in 1970 and has become a classic throughout the US, Canada, and the Spanish-speaking world.
